## The IEC "Unlimited" Apprenticeship curriculum is...

- A comprehensive four-year program reviewed and updated annually by the IEC National Apprenticeship & Training Committee.
- Approved nationally by the Bureau of Apprenticeship and Training and locally by the State Apprenticeship Councils in CT & MA (MA approval pending).
- Reviewed by the American Council on Education awarding up to 40 college credits to apprentices completing four years of the IEC training curriculum.
- Based on 720 hours of classroom training and 8,000 hours on-the-job training.
- Offered by most of the IEC chapters throughout the country allowing transferable credits.
- Open to students from other schools. Transfer students are welcome.

#### Our training is...

- The BEST training available to "independent" apprentices in CT & MA based on the most recent National Electrical Code.
- Taught at a state-of-the-art training facility by Certified Instructors who are highly committed, knowledgeable and are hired annually by the IEC New England Apprenticeship Committee.
- Not subsidized by any state or other funding programs.
- Designed so that students are required to pass a math assessment and be certified in CPR in order to complete a given year of the program.
- Includes the required OSHA 30 course.
- Overseen by an active Apprenticeship Committee that determines policies and procedures and is concerned about your progress.

#### **Class Information:**

- A mandatory orientation for new and transfer students is scheduled for Wednesday, August 20, 2025 at 5:30 pm.
- Classes begin for returning students on Monday, August 25th OR Tuesday, August 26th 2025 at 5:30 pm.
- Classes are held on Monday & Wednesday or Tuesday & Thursday evenings, 5:30–8:30 pm at IEC New England, 273 Dividend Road, Suite A, Rocky Hill, CT.
- All transfer students must provide transcripts, take a math assessment and/or test out prior to entering the program.

Tuition: Tuition does not include books/materials (see other side for all related fees).

#### **Book Payment: MUST accompany registration for returning students:**

- Books are purchased prior to the start of school for use during the entire year; some are used for multiple years.
- 6.35% sales tax and shipping & handling charges is included in the cost of books.
- Books will be available at the orientation for 1st year and transfer students and the 1st night of class at the school (unless on backorder).
